WAYS YOU CAN HELP

- 1. Sponsor a student:** You can donate \$8000* to fully cover the cost of tuition for one student, for all four years of study.
- 2. Support a student:** You can provide \$4000* to cover the fees that one student has to pay themselves towards their education, for all four years of study.
- 3. Offer an internship:** You can give a student the opportunity to undertake a 3-month paid internship with your office once they have completed their third year of study, allowing them to learn from you and refine their skills. This should include support for the cost of living and assistance with accommodation.



As KhSA seeks to strengthen relationships with supporters, partners and donors, we can offer you:

- Invitations to presentations, critiques and project reviews, updates, progress reports and information on student(s) who you have supported. If you wish, you can build closer relationships with the student(s) through giving lectures, mentoring, critiquing and technical or professional dialogue on their projects.
- Publicised information about your support, patronage and collaboration on the school's website and social media pages.
- An invitation onto the school's Scholarship Commission, participating in the selection of scholarship recipients.
- Engagement with the students and identification of student(s) with whom you would like work more closely, sponsor or support for an internship.
- Invitations as honorary/guest speakers during opening and closing of the academic year.
- Official enrolment as a Patron of the Kharkiv School of Architecture.
- Involvement in and engagement with the school's development, via exchanges and communication with the student(s), teaching staff and administration.
